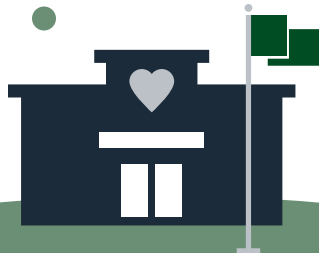
STUDENTS

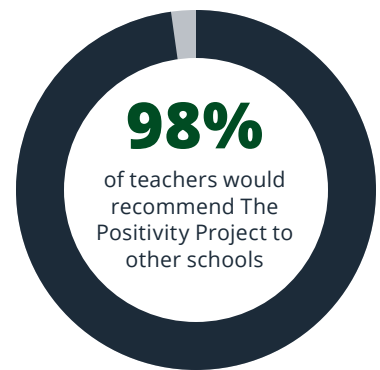
